Motions: ① Children lift right hands and knock three times. Sometimes the music is omitted for the "three knocks". ② Boys sing and make the following motions: Point to girls, cup right hand behind right ear, point up. ③ Girls make motions as boys in previous score. ④ Hold palms of hands in vertical position, a short distance apart, and widen space gradually. ⑤ Point to heaven. ⑥ Point to heart.
